RESPONSE – Item #2:

Wall by window (Right Side of House): Water came in crack during Superstorm Sandy. No standing water on floor – went directly into sump/drain. Contractor to seal – date: TBD.

Wall by window (Left Side of House): Water came in crack during Superstorm Sandy. No standing water on floor – went directly into sump/drain. Contractor to seal – date: TBD.

Wall by outlet box: Contractor sealed the wall.

Wall under Egress Window - Contractor sealed the wall.

RESPONSE – Item #3:

Roof Leak (2007): Occurred one time in 2007. Under warranty, roofing contractor came out and nailed in loose shingles. No further leaks except Ice Damming (See below). Ice Damming (2009): Occurred one time in December 2009. Insulation was added in January 2011. No further incidents.

RESPONSE – Item #14:

Sampling activities performed under the auspices of the Maryland Department of Environment ("MDE") revealed that arsenic was present in the soil at the Property above a site specific remediation goal of 20 milligrams per kilogram ("mg/kg") as established by the MDE. A Remedial Action, including removal of the soil, was performed on the Property pursuant to a Remedial Action Plan dated April 17, 2012 (approved by the MDE on August 16, 2012). It is expected that the MDE has or will approve the Remedial Action and will issue a letter acknowledging no further action is required by the MDE on the Property.

RESPONSE – Item #19:

Window Leak – Master Bathroom (by toilet): Window leaked during Superstorm Sandy. Caulked window – no further leaks.

Window Leak - Master Bathroom (by bathtub): Window leaked - had the window caulked - no further leaks.
